CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Young swimmers should ALWAYS:

- ✓ Treat Sports Leaders who may be teachers, coaches, club officials or parents with respect.
- ✓ Play fairly at all times, do their best.
- ✓ Respect team members, even when things go wrong
- ✓ Respect opponents, be gracious in defeat.
- ✓ Abide by the rules set down by Swim Ireland and their Club.
- ✓ Talk to the Coach, Team Captains, Club Children's Officer or Committee Member if they have any problems.

Young swimmers should NEVER:

1. Cheat
2. Use violence
3. Use physical contact that is not allowed within the rules.
4. Shout or argue with coaches, officials, team mates or opponents
5. Harm team members, opponents or their property.
6. Bully or use bullying tactics to isolate another person.
7. Use unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage.
8. Use bad language
9. Take banned substances
10. Keep secrets about any person who may have caused them harm
11. Tell lies about adults / young people
12. Spread Rumors
13. Behave in a manner that might bring Asgard Swimming Club or Swim Ireland into disrepute.
